Mission Statement:

Atlético Santa Rosa is dedicated to providing children and young adults in our community with the resources and knowledge necessary to improve their soccer skills and education. We promote the fundamental values of sportsmanship in addition to physical and mental education in a healthy and safe environment.

Our goals are to provide continuous growth on all levels of competition, to enhance the technical, tactical, and athletic aspects of soccer in each individual player, and form a supportive and positive social attitude within and outside the soccer community.

Season:

The season begins in March and is played year-round. This includes training, games, and tournaments.

Games, Tournaments, and Costs:

Most tournaments are played Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. The locations of these tournaments cover the Bay Area, Sacramento, and Northern California. All costs associated with games and tournaments are shared equally by all parents.

The list of tournaments to be played will be discussed with parents at the first team meeting and will be chosen based on team level and annual player development plan.

Player Fees:

Players ages 6-19 will pay \$80 per month. Players playing high school soccer will be charged for 9 months only. Players not playing high school soccer will be charged for the entire 12 months.

New Players: \$200 Registration fee. (money order or cashier's check)

Monthly Payment Methods: Automatic Clearing House (ACH only)

Returning Players: \$100 Registration fee annually (ACH only - paid by March 5th)

- Volunteers are not compensated.
- Trainers at the club will be compensated according to the number of players on the roster.
- Financial surplus is used for fields, insurance, affiliation fees and administrative fees as well as maintaining the office and website.

Trainers:

All our instructors are highly skilled, trained, and have extensive knowledge of the game through professional experience.

Atlético SR welcomes everyone and looks forward to continuing the program and nurturing our relationship with the community. We have various levels of teams available to maximize our players' potential, regardless of their experience. We offer our unconditional support, dedicated training, and extensive knowledge to our members.

Player Code of Conduct

It is the policy of Atlético Santa Rosa that members' shall conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike and positive manner when representing the Atlético Santa Rosa Club at games, practices, tournaments, and other club related activities. No member of the club shall act in a way that brings discredit to the club. Club members are defined as players, parents, guardians, coaches, trainers, and other club supporters.

The following acts or activities are strictly prohibited. These rules apply directly to any member of Atlético Santa Rosa. Any club member that is found to have committed any of the below list of offenses, may be subject to disciplinary action.

- Falsification of records.
- Use, consumption, and/or possession of any illegal drug or alcoholic beverages.
- Use of tobacco in any form may not be consumed within 200 yards of practices or games.
- Foul or offensive language or gestures.
- Engaging in illegal activities while traveling with the club.
- Inappropriate dress or attire that violates social views on decency.
- Offensive, lewd or indecent acts.
- Hostile or abusive acts, language, or threats upon persons or officials.
- Firearms are prohibited.
- Littering.
- Provoking or inducing confrontation.
- Throwing, tossing, or propelling any object(s)
- Reckless or dangerous driving with club members present.

Interference by Spectators: Atlético considers encouraging of violent play, foul language, intimidation or unsportsmanlike behavior from a spectator as interfering with the game.

It is the responsibility of the head coach, with the aid of the assistant coach and team manager, to ensure that all members of the team uphold this policy.

Procedures:

In order to ensure compliance with this policy the following procedures shall be instituted:

Team Coaches Shall:

- Exercise their authority to substitute any player who is in violation of this policy.
- Exercise their authority to direct that any non-player member of the club may be removed from the area of the field if that individual is in violation of this policy.

The President Shall:

- Investigate all reports of involving a player.
- Initiate a corrective action plan with the team coach and manager.

Atletico Santa Rosa Members Code of Conduct

- Each club member (player, parent, coach, board member, or any person with approved “membership” to ASR) will be responsible for conducting themselves in accordance with the policy, as well as the following rules.
- As a member, I represent Atlético Santa Rosa, its teams, and Santa Rosa Community as a whole. My behavior must be exemplary at all games and club functions. I will conduct myself as a role model at all times. I understand that I am obligated to follow all ASR rules, and all rules of US Soccer, US Youth Soccer, NCPL and US Club Soccer.
- I understand that as member, punctuality is critical to each team’s success, and that I will do my part to assures that punctuality in the appropriate capacity (weather as a player or parent etc.).
- I understand that I am responsible for and agree to pay all team fees and any fines. Failure to pay team fees/fines in a timely manner may result in being suspended from the team until said fees are paid.
- I recognize the importance of volunteer treasurers and managers. They are essential to the development of each team and player. I agree to be respectful to these treasurers/managers and encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other soccer events. I will applaud a good effort both in victory and defeat. I will refrain from using abusive or profane language at all times. I will accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being called fair, and to the best ability of said officials. I will not criticize officials, opposing teams, players, coaches, or fans by word of mouth or by gestures. I will never verbally abuse a player, parent, coach or official.
- I will report all injuries to the coach in a timely manner. I will place the emotional and physical well being of players and teammates ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will refrain from use of alcohol, tobacco and drugs at all youth soccer events. I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child when participating in the ASR club by following the Code of Conduct.
- I understand that if I do not follow these rules of conduct, my membership in the ASR Club may be affected, as determined by the club board or president.

Play with Integrity: One of the most essential lessons a child can learn from sports is to follow the rules. Make sure your team understands the rules and doesn't break them, even if they have the opportunity to get away with it.

Respect the Officials: It's important to teach not only our young athletes but also our parents and coaches to respect the referees and officials. Our kids have a watchful eye and take notice when parents and coaches are disrespectful.

Be a Good Sport. This means doing what we can to lift our teammates up and help them reach their potential. Being a good teammate means also being a good person on and off the field regardless of the outcome.

Maintain Self-Control. Keep your cool, have a positive attitude, and don't overreact during practice or games. Be encouraging of other players.

Let the Coach's Coach: Avoid chiming in with your coaching advice for the team, or other parents. Let those in charge run the plays.

Penalties that may be imposed by the club include:

Repeated or serious violation of this policy may result in penalties including oral and written reprimand, monitoring of future behavior by an outside official, and/or probationary status. Any sanction shall be imposed only after appropriate warning, notice of alleged violation, and hearing before the appropriate officials.

1. If any game is interrupted because of behavioral issues, involved parties will have to comply with a NorCal PAD Committee suspension and a club suspension.
2. Depending on the gravity of the incident various suspensions may include the following disciplinary actions by the club:
 - a) 3 months suspension from practices and games
 - b) 6 months suspension from practice and games
 - c) 1 year suspension from practice and games
 - d) Release from the club

We have read the Code of Conduct and agree to abide by all terms and conditions.

Presupuesto

- A) Nuestra Misión: Nuestra filosofía es la de proporcionar a los niños y jóvenes futbolistas la mejor alternativa para aprender y jugar fútbol, en un ambiente sano y seguro, que promueva la formación integral y la diversión con el mejor programa que combina fútbol, valores, y educación.
- B) Duración de la temporada: La temporada es de Marzo a Febrero del siguiente año. Tanto torneos como entrenamientos darán comienzo el mes de Marzo a Diciembre del presente año. Diciembre a Marzo es la temporada de invierno, si entrena dos días a la semana.
- C) Competencias y Torneos: Los gastos que esto implica serán compartidos en partes equitativas entre todos los padres de familia. La mayoría de los torneos se efectuarán los viernes sábados y domingos, los cuales abarcan el Área de la Bahía, Sacramento y el Norte de California.
- D) Costos por temporada: Todas las personas que forman la directiva son voluntarios que no perciben sueldo por sus servicios prestados a la escuela de fútbol. Las únicas personas que están autorizadas a recibir sueldo son los entrenadores a los cuales se les paga \$50 dólares por niño. Los niños pagarán \$80 dólares al mes. El resto del dinero se utiliza para la renta de los campos, el seguro para las canchas, gastos de filiación para US club soccer, gastos administrativos como; sobres, tintas, copias y mantenimiento de la página red.
- E) Aproximadamente la temporada sale en mil dólares para cada jugador que incluye todos los gastos.
- F) El registro para nuevos alumnos es de \$200 dólares por jugador, el cual recibirá credencial, 2 playeras de entrenamiento, short de entrenamiento, y valija. A los niños que ya están en el club a cada año se cobra una taja de \$100 dólares, por la registración.
- G) Métodos de pago: Todos los pagos deben hacerse por Automatic Clearing House (ACH), money order, or cashier's check. El Club no acepta dinero efectivo, o cheques personales.
- H) Entrenadores: Todos nuestros entrenadores son personas capacitadas para efectuar su trabajo, teniendo una trayectoria limpia a nivel personal y profesional. Cada uno de ellos se ha desarrollado en el campo futbolístico por cual cuentan con una amplia experiencia.
- I) La Escuela de Fútbol Atlético Santa Rosa es una institución que brinda todo su apoyo y tiene sus puertas abiertas a todas las personas, esto implica que no efectúa pruebas previas para que puedan entrar los niños. La escuela cuenta con niveles recreativos, competitivos y de alto rendimiento. Ofrece su apoyo incondicional en el rendimiento futbolístico de los niños.
